[PL 111-216](#) - The Airline Safety and Federal Aviation Administration Extension Act of 2010 - Officially signed into law on August 1, 2010

[House Bill H.R. 5900](#) - Airline Safety and Federal Aviation Administration Extension Act of 2010

[Senate Bill S.1163](#) - Bill introduced by Senator Charles Schumer (NY) mandating a non-industry expert to participate in the FAA Administrator's Management Advisory Council

[Senate Bill S.1283](#) - Bill introduced by Senator Charles Schumer (NY) mandating air carriers to fully disclose the actual operator of each flight segment during the booking process

[Senate Bill S.1284](#) - Bill introduced by Senator Olympia Snowe (ME) mandates several critical safety issues be reflected in new FAA regulations and new processes be implemented to ensure one level of safety across all air carriers

[House Bill H.R.915](#) - FAA Reauthorization Bill that includes several amendments relating to aviation safety

[House Bill H.R.3371](#) - Airline Safety and Pilot Training Improvement Act of 2009 - Stand-alone

aviation safety bill passed by the House on October 13th by a vote of 409-11.

[Senate Bill S.1451](#) - FAA Air Transportation Modernization and Safety Improvement Act - the Senate's FAA Reauthorization Bill with numerous aviation safety provisions related to the issues associated with Flight 3407

[Senate Bill S.1744](#) - Enhancing Flight Crewmembers' Training - Proposed by Senator Charles Schumer (NY), requiring all pilots to have an Airline Transport Pilot (ATP) license prior to being hired by a commercial airline.
